**Zinio for Libraries** is a free online service that allows you to download free digital copies of your favorite magazines to your computer, tablet, or smartphone.

## What Do I need?

- A Monroe County Library System card in good standing
- An email address

## Common Compatible Devices:

- Computer (PC or Mac)
- Apple Devices
- Android Devices
- Kindle Fire & Kindle Fire HD
- Blackberry Playbook Devices

**NOTE:** At this time, Zinio is NOT compatible with Nook devices.



## First Time Users:

### ➔ STEP ONE: Library Account

- 1) Click on the "Zinio" link at the Pittsford Community Library website, <http://www.townofpittsford.org/library>.
- 2) Click on the "Create New Account" link in the upper right-hand corner.
- 3) Enter your library card number.
- 4) Fill out your information to create your account.
- 5) You will receive an email from RBdigital Gateway with a link to access your account.
- 6) Choose a magazine by tapping or clicking the cover.
- 7) A new screen will show the magazine and you can choose "checkout."
- 8) Once you checkout the magazine, a pop up box will appear saying, "Success!" An example is shown below.



- 9) If you are using a tablet or smartphone, do not click the "Start Reading" button, instead click the link to "GET THE NEW APP to read offline" and follow Step Two.
- 10) If you are reading on a PC or Mac, choose the "Start Reading" button and enjoy the magazine.


### ➔ STEP TWO: Get the App

- 1) In your app store, get the "Zinio for Libraries" app.
- 2) Once the app is downloaded, open it and tap the login button.
- 3) Follow the instructions: select country, state, our library, and then sign in with your account (the one you just set up).
- 4) You should see the magazine you checked out. If not, click the settings icon in the upper left corner. That will open a menu where you can choose "Sync Library." Close out the menu with the X. You should see the magazine(s) you checked out.
- 5) Download the magazine by tapping it, and you can start reading.




### To Checkout More Magazines:

- 1) Go to : [www.townofpittsford.org/library](http://www.townofpittsford.org/library) and then login to PCL's Zinio.
- 2) Follow steps 6-8 in Step One.
- 3) On a tablet or smartphone, open the Zinio for Libraries app and follow steps 4-5 in Step Two.

### To Delete a Magazine

- Once you have downloaded a magazine, click "Edit" in the upper right corner.
- Tap the circle with an x in it and the magazine will be deleted. An example is shown in the picture below.
- Click "Done" in the upper right corner to return to your magazines.
