#### IF YOU RECEIVE FEDERAL BENEFITS, ELECTRONIC PAYMENT IS REQUIRED BY 3/1/13

Everyone who receives federal benefit payments by **paper check** is required by the U.S. Department of the Treasury to switch to an electronic payment option by March 1, 2013. **This includes senior citizens, veterans, people with disabilities, and others who receive a paper check in the mail for social security, VA or other Federal benefit payments.** 

The U.S. Treasury Department and Federal Reserve Banks have developed a public education campaign called "Go Direct" which explains the need to switch to electronic payments and the two Treasury-recommended options for receiving electronic payments (direct deposit or direct express debit card). If you are receiving a paper check for your federal benefits such as social security, you must switch to electronic payment by the 3/1/12 deadline.
