

SCHOOL "FULL" TAX PAYMENT DEADLINE IS THURSDAY, 10/31

The deadline for making full School Tax payments at Town Hall, with a 2% interest penalty, is Thursday, 10/31. The Tax Office will be open regular hours that day from 9AM - 5PM. Beginning 11/1, all School Tax payments must be made to the Monroe County Treasurer at P.O. Box 14420, Rochester NY 14614 - please refer to the back of your School Tax bill for further payment instructions. No payments will be accepted after 11/18 at the Monroe County Treasury. Please note the Passport Express service offered by Monroe County at Pittsford Town Hall will close at 3PM (instead of 4PM) today, Wednesday, 10/9 and will open at 12 noon (instead of 9AM) on Wednesday, 10/16. Regular hours (9AM - 4PM) will resume on Wednesday, 10/23.

PROPOSED 2014 TOWN BUDGET FILED | BUDGET HEARING IS 10/15

Town Supervisor Sandy Zutes has filed her 2014 budget proposal. The proposed 2014 Operating Budget is \$15.6 million, which is 2.16% (\$330,299) above the 2013 budget. Of this increase, 51% (\$170,094) is driven by outside forces, such as increases in health insurance and mandated New York State Retirement contributions. The proposed town tax rate of \$2.71 per \$1,000 of assessed property value reflects a 10th straight year of no tax rate increase for the Town of Pittsford.

The Supervisor's 2014 budget proposal is available to view at the Pittsford Town Clerk's office, 11 S. Main Street in Pittsford. It is also available on the Town website at the "Budgets" link under General Information, or by clicking HERE. The 2014 budget public hearing will be held at the next Town Board meeting, which is Tuesday, 10/15 at 7PM in the lower level meeting room of Town Hall. All residents are welcome to attend.

Items accepted for consignment must be valued at \$20 or more and cannot be clothing items (i.e. jackets, dresses, purses, shoes, etc.). Sale hours are 9AM - 7PM, Wednesday, 10/23 through Friday, 10/25. Thursday is the 25% off sale day, Friday is half-price day.
