WHEREAS, a Petition, signed by the sole joint owners of the proposed "Extension SWBC No. 49 (Spiliotis residence)" to the Pittsford Sewer District, has been presented to the Town Board of Pittsford, Monroe County, New York, the said proposed Extension being located, in general terms, on the real property located at 1762 Calkins Road, Pittsford, New York, all as is more particularly set forth in the Petition; and

WHEREAS, no public monies are proposed to be expended for the Extension of the District; and

WHEREAS, the anticipated Sewer Entrance, Connection and other County Fees to be paid by the owner of each unit within the Extension, in the first year following the proposed Extension, are in the aggregate amount of \$551.98;

NOW, ON MOTION duly made and seconded, it is

RESOLVED AND ORDERED, that a public hearing be held before the Town Board of the Town of Pittsford, at the Town of Pittsford Town Hall, on the 16th day of October, 2018 at 6:00 o'clock P.M., Local Time, to consider the said Petition and to hear all persons interested therein, and for such other and further action on the part of the Town Board with relation to the said Petition as may be required by law or proper in the premises; and it is further

RESOLVED AND ORDERED, that a copy of the within Order be duly published in the Brighton-Pittsford Post, which paper is designated as the official paper for such publication, and a copy of the said Order be posted on the bulletin board of the Town Clerk of the Town of

Pittsford, New York, maintained pursuant to Section 30 of the Town Law, not less than ten (10) nor more than twenty (20) days prior to the date of the said hearing.
