UPDATE FROM SUPERVISOR BILL SMITH:

19TH AMENDMENT CENTENNIAL, PROPERTY TAX PAYMENTS, AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAM, MASK REMINDER

Yesterday we marked the 100th anniversary of the 19th Amendment's ratification. We're celebrating the **19th Amendment Centennial** and Pittsford's history of supporting the women's suffrage movement with a self-guided walking tour and a tour of the Pittsford Political Equality Club founders' gravesites at Pittsford Cemetery - both underway now through the end of the month - and a socially distanced fireworks display in the Village on August 22. Our Town Clerk's Office will be allowed to collect **school tax payments** starting September 1. Town of Pittsford residents will receive their 2020-2021 school tax bills in the mail by or after September 1, 2020. If your bill does not arrive by Tuesday, September 8, please call the tax office at 585-248-6215. To best observe health safety practices for both the public and our staff, the Town will accept payments by mail or by our secure drop slot located to the right of the front door of the Pittsford Town Hall. Or, you may want to consider online payment; for this tax season only, **the customary 3% service fee for online payment is waived**. After a safe and enjoyable Summer Camp season, our Recreation Department team is finalizing plans for our **After School program**. The staff is working diligently to organize this program with health and safety in mind while keeping the fun and engaging approach for which our programs are well known. Pre-Registration for returning participants has begun. If space is still available after this Friday, August 21, registration for the remaining spots will open at noon on Monday, August 24 for new participants. As you get out to enjoy the remaining days of summer, please do remember to **keep a mask or face covering with you and use it** if there is a chance you will be within 6 feet of others outside of your family or quarantine group.

Now is the perfect time to take advantage of our **parks and trails**. We maintain nearly 115 acres of active parkland, including Thornell Farm Park, Hopkins Park, Great Embankment Park, and Carpenter Park at the Port of Pittsford. The trails and access ways in the Town of Pittsford total almost 38 miles. They provide hikers interesting destinations, quiet seclusion, and an enjoyable means to get some fresh air and exercise.

PITTSFORD 19TH AMENDMENT CENTENNIAL - SOCIAL DISTANCING FIREWORKS DISPLAY 8/22, WALKING TOURS THROUGH 8/31

This year marks the 100th anniversary of the 19th Amendment's ratification, which gave women in America the right to vote. Pittsford is honoring this important milestone and celebrating our history of supporting the women's suffrage movement.

A **social distancing fireworks display** will be held in the Village of Pittsford on Saturday, August 22 at 9:00pm to celebrate the 19th Amendment Centennial in Pittsford. Those wishing to view the fireworks are encouraged to do so from inside of or near their parked cars. The fireworks will be visible throughout the center of the Village. If you are in a public area to view the fireworks please **remain at least 6 feet from others outside of your family or quarantine group and wear a mask or face covering even though you are outdoors**. Masks are needed as others may walk past you; **if you cannot be at least 6 feet from those outside of your group at all times, a mask is necessary**.

Please note gatherings of crowds will not be allowed; gatherings of crowds to view the fireworks display will force their cancellation that night. Please observe these rules for the safety of all and to ensure the fireworks display can take place.

It is up to each of us to make sure we can all stay safe and enjoy the fireworks - please wear your mask and stay six feet from others!

Our **self-guided walking tour** will feature the people and places in Pittsford important to advancing women's voting rights. There will be a **self-guided cemetery tour** of the Pittsford Political Equality Club charter members' gravesites at Pittsford Cemetery as well. Tour information will be uploaded to our [Pittsford 19th Amendment Celebration website](#) later this week; both tours will take place August 18 - 31.

We're also partnering with the Women's Club of Pittsford to host **voter engagement tables** from 9:00am - 1:00pm on August 22 at the Pittsford Village Farmers Market (35 Lincoln Avenue, behind the Spiegel Pittsford Community Center) and on August 29 at the Pittsford Farmers Market at Colony Plaza, 3400 Monroe Avenue.

All activities will follow appropriate COVID-19 health safety and physical distancing guidelines. Event details will be posted on the Town and Village websites and shared on social media as the dates approach. We hope you will join us in the celebration and perhaps learn something new about women's suffrage in Pittsford!

TAX INFORMATION - REMINDER

Town of Pittsford residents will receive their 2020-2021 school tax bills in the mail by or after September 1, 2020. If your bill does not arrive by Tuesday, September 8, please call the tax office at 585-248-6215. Legally we cannot accept payment until September 1. Full payments without interest will be accepted through Thursday, October 1. First installments are due by Tuesday, September 15. Consistent with our practice since the onset of the pandemic, the Town will continue to accept payments by mail, by the secure mail slot located to the right of the front door of the Pittsford Town Hall, 11 South Main Street, and online by a link from the Town's website to the County's online payment portal. Visa and MasterCard will be accepted for online payments, **and for this tax season only**, the customary 3% service fee to use the online payment service is waived. To pay online, click [here](#). You can also pay your tax at the Canandaigua National Bank at 18 State Street.

Payment for First Installments AFTER SEPTEMBER 16 will be accepted only from September 17 - September 21 (because September 20 falls on a Sunday), with 1% interest.

Please Note: **we strongly discourage paying your tax bill via Electronic Checking directly from your bank account.** If you do this, it means that your bank mails us a paper check -- without a postmark. Experience has shown that this can take as long as two weeks to reach our office. Therefore, we cannot consider your payment received until we physically receive the paper check, and you risk having to pay interest on the late payment, which is mandated by the State and that the Town has no authority to waive. **We do not recommend sending payment in this manner.**

Town Facility Closures

Spiegel Pittsford Community Center - building is open for summer day camp and appointments only on weekdays from 8:00am-4:00pm as of Monday, June 29. Senior "Grab N Go" meals will continue every Wednesday. Registration for low-risk activities and virtual programs is underway. See Program Info & Registration link at www.townofpittsford.org/home-recreation. Programs will continue to open as we receive further guidance.

Pittsford Community Library - the Library is now open for limited hours and services; enter from the parking lot entrance. Curbside pickup is available on Saturdays. The Library also has many online resources, programs and activities for all ages to enjoy. For current Library hours, services, resources, and other updates, visit the Library's update page at www.bit.ly/your-library-at-home. For virtual children's programming check the Library's Facebook page www.facebook.com/PittsfordLibrary/. The Book Drop return area is open; please only deposit returned books, donations are not being accepted at this time. Regular due dates for all materials have resumed; check your receipt or your Library account for exact due dates. Curbside pickup of Library materials is available for Monroe County Library System cardholders.

Town Hall is open to residents by appointment only; in-person meetings will be limited and allowed only when absolutely necessary. Calls should be made to the department related to the inquiry. Town Hall remains staffed to handle business online and by mail, phone, email and the "drop slot" to the right of the front door of Town Hall.

Town Clerk: All services of the Town Clerk are available online, by mail, phone and email. If necessary, an appointment can be arranged. Town Court: As of July, Pittsford Town Court sessions are being scheduled on a limited basis. Those scheduled to report to Court will be notified by mail in advance. Town Court staff are available via phone and email Monday - Friday from 9:00am - 5:00pm; call (585) 248-6238 or email at pdromgoole@townofpittsford.org. Visitors must follow appropriate health safety and social distancing requirements for Court appearances and Court Office visits.

All Town Playgrounds: residents may use Town playgrounds at their own risk, as it is not possible for the Town to keep equipment appropriately sanitized after every use. Those using Town playgrounds are expected to observe COVID-19 social distancing and hygiene protocols.

All Town Parks: all Town parks are open; all courts are open, all athletic fields are open to groups of 25 individuals or less, and all trails and walkways are accessible. Those using Town parks are expected to observe COVID-19 social distancing and hygiene protocols.

Thornell Farm Park: the park is open and per State requirements, all grass and turf sports fields are open to group activities of 25 individuals or less; the tennis courts, trails, walkways and the playground are open to residents. COVID-19 social distancing and hygiene protocols are required.

King's Bend Park Lodges: the lodges are open for reservations; per State and Federal governments all COVID-19 safety guidelines must be followed while at the lodges. Lodge capacities will adhere to New York State COVID-19 guidelines. Please note COVID-19 social distancing and hygiene protocols are required.

The Mile Post School: the building is closed to the public until further notice, as the site is being used as a Public Works crew operation center.

Building Department: As of May 15, 2020 the Governor has begun the phased reopening of New York State. The Town of Pittsford and the surrounding Finger Lakes region have met the criteria set by the Governor to reopen. Construction is included in Phase 1 of the reopening plan. As construction moves forward, all COVID-19 safety guidelines set by the State and Federal governments must be followed while on the job site. To protect the community and limit the spread of COVID-19, the Town of Pittsford has altered accordingly its inspection and permitting procedures. Town Public Works - Highway, Sewer and Parks Departments: All operations continue. Crews in these departments are following hygiene and social distancing protocols in light of the COVID-19 threat.

Monroe County Services at Town facilities:

The County has suspended until further notice Passport Services at Town Hall and Mobile DMV service at Pittsford Town Court. Per the NYS Department of Motor Vehicles, all driver licenses, learner permits, non-driver identification cards, vehicle registrations and vehicle inspections scheduled to expire on or after March 1, 2020 are extended until further notice and all temporary registration documents are valid until further notice. This extension does NOT apply to insurance coverage - motor vehicle liability insurance coverage must be maintained at all times during the extension period.
