A Message from Supervisor Smith:

PITTSFORD RECEIVES OVER \$84K IN CARES ACT FUNDS

Good news for Pittsford! Earlier this month I signed an Inter-municipal Agreement between the Town and Monroe County, for the Town to receive more than \$84,000 in funding under the CARES Act provided by the County. These funds will help recoup some of the COVID-19 expenses the Town has incurred. Expenses such as plexi-glass, sanitizer stands and dispensers, work pods, personal protective equipment, additional laptops, technology protective upgrades, thermometers, signage, etc.

My thanks to our splendid Town staff, especially Finance Director Brian Luke, Assistant to the Commissioner of Public Works Renee McQuillen and IT Director Joy Brown, who pulled together the data supporting the Town's application and made this award possible.

Thanks to County Executive Adam Bello for making this funding available to us, and to our County Legislators representing Pittsford – Howard Maffucci, Karla Boyce and Mike Yudelson – for supporting it.

I value the strong cooperative relationship between the County and the Town that makes successes like this possible. As I'll never tire of saying: both within our own community and in our relations with other communities and other levels of government, we work best when we work together.

FOOD CUPBOARD TO OFFER DELIVERY TO SENIORS IN PITTSFORD

The Pittsford Food Cupboard will begin in January to offer delivery of groceries and supplies to senior citizens that reside in Pittsford. There are no income requirements to participate. Seniors interested in receiving home delivery must sign up for the program in

person at the Pittsford Food Cupboard offices. The Food Cupboard will offer fresh produce, wholesome breads, frozen meat and dairy items in addition to non-perishable canned goods. Deliveries will be available on the second and fourth Friday of each month, between 11:00am and 2:00pm.

Those who wish to receive home delivery must meet and follow these guidelines:

- Reside in the 14534 zip code
- Be 65 years of age or older
- Sign up for the program in person at the Food Cupboard office; please bring a picture ID and current piece of mail to verify your address
- Be able to call the morning of your delivery to choose menu items or to leave a message with your food preferences
- Someone must be home to accept the order when it is delivered

The **winter delivery dates** (second and fourth Friday of the month) are: January 8 and 22, February 12 and 26, March 12 and 26.

The Pittsford Food Cupboard is open Tuesdays and Fridays from 9:30am – 1:30pm and the first and third Saturday of each month from 9:30 – 11:30am. For more information, call (585) 264-9860 and ask for Claire or visit www.pittsfordfoodcupboard.net.

PROPERTY TAX BILLS AND INFORMATION

The 2021 Town and County property tax bills will be mailed to residents on December 31, 2020. Your property tax information may be obtained through the Monroe County website after December 31, 2020 at <http://www.monroecounty.gov/apps/propertyapp.php>. We recommend that you consult with your accountant if you are considering prepayment of your 2021 Town and County taxes before the end of this calendar year, to determine if this is a beneficial action for you to take, given the federal and state tax laws that are in effect. Please notify the Town Tax office (585-248-6215) if you are mailing in a prepayment with a U.S. postmark of December 31, 2020, so that you are properly receipted for this payment. The earliest that the Town Tax Office may have the 2021 property tax amounts available will be December 30 or 31, 2020.

SEASONAL PARKING RESTRICTIONS IN EFFECT THROUGH APRIL 1, 2021

In order to facilitate snow removal, Town of Pittsford seasonal parking restrictions are currently in effect through April 1, 2021. Parking of any vehicle on public roads - including state highways and on the shoulder of all roads - is prohibited each year from November 15 through April 1 in all areas within the Town and outside of the Village. During this time, please don't park on or along public roads outside of the Village. Please note violators may be ticketed or towed.

When the snow flies, we need roadsides clear of vehicles so our plows can get through. This is especially true in neighborhoods, where the streets are narrower. Vehicles parked along the roadside can hinder plows accessing your neighborhood. Please help us keep our streets safe and accessible!

ASL INTERPRETER ALWAYS AVAILABLE AT TOWN BOARD MEETINGS

Town Facility Closures

Spiegel Pittsford Community Center - building is open 8:00am - 5:00pm Monday through Friday and open during program hours evenings and weekends. Senior "Grab N Go" meals will continue every Wednesday and Friday; pickup is at the bus loop behind the Community Center. Registration for low-risk activities and virtual programs begins in advance of each session. See Program Info & Registration link at www.townofpittsford.org/home-recreation. Programs will continue to open as we receive further guidance.

Pittsford Community Library - the Library is now open for limited hours and services; enter from the parking lot entrance. The Library also has many online resources, programs and activities for all ages to enjoy. For current Library hours, services, resources, and other updates, visit the Library's update page at www.bit.ly/pclupdates. For virtual children's programming check the Library's Facebook page www.facebook.com/PittsfordLibrary/. The Book Drop return area is open; please only deposit returned books; for information on book sale donations visit www.pittsfordlibraryfriends.com. Regular due dates for all materials have resumed; check your receipt or your Library account for exact due dates. Low contact pickup of Library materials is available for Monroe County Library System cardholders.

Town Hall is open to residents by appointment only; in-person meetings will be limited and allowed only when absolutely necessary. Calls should be made to the department related to the inquiry. Town

Hall remains staffed to handle business online and by mail, phone, email and the "drop slot" to the right of the front door of Town Hall.

Town Clerk: All services of the Town Clerk are available online, by mail, phone and email. If necessary, an appointment can be arranged. Town Court: Pittsford Town Court sessions are being scheduled on a limited basis. Town Court staff are available via phone and email Monday - Friday from 9:00am - 5:00pm; call (585) 248-6238 or email at pdromgoole@townofpittsford.org. Visitors must follow appropriate health safety and social distancing requirements for Court appearances and Court Office visits.

All Town Playgrounds: residents may use Town playgrounds at their own risk, as it is not possible for the Town to keep equipment appropriately sanitized after every use. Those using Town playgrounds are expected to observe COVID-19 social distancing and hygiene protocols.

All Town Parks: Farm View Park and Hopkins Park are closed as of November 2020 and will remain closed through the spring of 2021. All other Town parks remain open; all courts are open, all athletic fields are open to groups of 25 individuals or less, and all trails and walkways are accessible. Those using Town parks are expected to observe COVID-19 social distancing and hygiene protocols.

Thornell Farm Park: the park is open and per State requirements, all grass and turf sports fields are open to group activities of 25 individuals or less; the tennis courts, trails, walkways and the playground are open to residents. COVID-19 social distancing and hygiene protocols are required.

King's Bend Park Lodges: the lodges are open for reservations; per State and Federal governments all COVID-19 safety guidelines must be followed while at the lodges. Lodge capacities will adhere to New York State COVID-19 guidelines. Please note COVID-19 social distancing and hygiene protocols are required.

The Mile Post School: the building is closed to the public until further notice, as the site is being used as a Public Works crew operation center.

Building Department: As of May 15, 2020 the Governor has begun the phased reopening of New York State. The Town of Pittsford and the surrounding Finger Lakes region have met the criteria set by the Governor to reopen. Construction is included in Phase 1 of the reopening plan. As construction moves forward, all COVID-19 safety guidelines set by the State and Federal governments must be followed while on the job site. To protect the community and limit the spread of COVID-19, the Town of Pittsford has altered accordingly its inspection and permitting procedures.
