ZONING CODE UPDATE TOWN BOARD MEETING IS JULY 9, 6PM AT TOWN HALL Neighborhood Residential Zoning changes to be



discussed; public participation needed

The Pittsford Town Board continues to conduct meetings to discuss the Town's Zoning Code Update. The next meeting will take place Tuesday, July 9 at 6:00 in the lower-level meeting room at Pittsford Town Hall, 11 South Main Street. The Board will discuss potential residential zoning changes that could affect every neighborhood. Public participation is important! The meeting is open to the public and will be live streamed.

At this meeting, the Board will continue to discuss Supplemental Regulations. If time permits, Non-Residential Use Regulations and then Exterior Lighting Regulations will be discussed as well. FIREWORKS ARE HEAVILY REGULATED IN NEW YORK STATE – KNOW THE LAW AND STAY SAFE!

In NYS, the use and sale of fireworks are heavily regulated. In Monroe County, only certain types of fireworks (known as "sparkling devices") are legal. These include ground-based or handheld devices that produce a shower of colored sparks, such as sparklers, fountains and cones. Statewide, the following types of fireworks are illegal: aerial consumer fireworks, chasers, firecrackers, Roman candles, salutes, rockets and metal wire sparklers.

The safest way to enjoy fireworks is to attend a professional fireworks display! If you decide to set off fireworks on your own, adhere to these safety guidelines:

- Follow local laws. Use only legal fireworks and adhere to local regulations.
- Have an adult present. Never allow small children to handle fireworks. Vigilant adult supervision is a must.

- **Keep water nearby.** Have a bucket of water or hose ready for emergencies.
- **Ignite fireworks one at a time**, then move back quickly.
- Never relight duds. If a firework doesn't go off, wait 20 minutes and then soak it in water.
- **Use fireworks outside only.** Fireworks should only be set off in open spaces away from buildings, dry grass and flammable materials.
- **Dispose of fireworks properly.** Douse used fireworks with water before throwing them away.
- Please be considerate of your neighbors. The abrupt booms, lights, and toxic fumes cause anxiety and can have a negative impact on pets, young children, those suffering with PTSD (especially war veterans) and wildlife. Keep a respectable distance from wildlife, residential areas and dispose of all debris.

and phone-in residents, builders, contractors, various professionals and volunteer board members. Excellent customer service, organizational, verbal and writing skills are required.


