

# EMERGENCY NOTIFICATION ALERTS AVAILABLE FOR PITTSFORD RESIDENTS

As we shared in the Spring, 2024 issue of our Pittsford Messenger newsletter, Monroe County offers localized emergency notifications to Pittsford residents through its Hyper-Reach service. New York State also has a mass notification system available to Pittsford residents via its NY-Alert program. See details below about these alert programs and how to sign for them. ### Monroe County Hyper-Reach Emergency Notifications

Pittsford residents can sign up to receive local emergency alerts through Monroe County's Hyper-Reach Emergency Notification service. Signing up allows your cell phone, email and/or TDD to be notified for local emergencies and community alerts as well. The program uses your address to provide alerts targeted to your specific geographic area. Home phone (landline) numbers are automatically registered with Monroe County's 911 Center for alerts; registering for Hyper-Reach allows notification via your mobile phone. Sign up is simple and free. Use the QR code below or go online to signup.hyper-reach.com.

### **NY Alert Emergency Notification System**

NY-Alert is New York State's Mass Notification System. By signing up for NY-Alert, you can receive alerts, warnings and emergency information via the web, your cell phone, email and other technologies. Users create an account and then subscribe to select the types of alerts they wish to receive.

NY-Alert contains public alerts and critical, emergency-related information including instructions and recommendations in real-time by emergency personnel. Information may include severe weather warnings, significant highway closures, hazardous material spills and other emergency conditions. Notifications also can include AMBER and missing children alerts, and alerts regarding consumer protection, public health and sex offender re-location. You can receive alerts by phone, text message, email and fax machine and may select multiple ways to be notified. ## SUMMER CONCERTS FOR KIDS BEGINS NEXT WEDNESDAY, JULY 17, WITH MISTERGREENE!



# PITTSFORD ROTARY FOOD DRIVE THIS SATURDAY, 9AM – 12PM

The Rotary Club of Pittsford's next food drive is scheduled for this Saturday, July 13, from 9:00am-noon at the Pittsford Sutherland High School bus loop. In addition to the Pittsford Food Cupboard, donations will support the Rochester Deaf Kitchen and the Nazareth University Oak Tree Food Pantry. Gently used recent issues (past 12 months) of magazines will also be collected for distribution to various social agencies in the Rochester area.



The <u>Pittsford Food Cupboard</u> plays a crucial role in addressing food insecurity within our community. Donations help ensure that local families have access to essential food items that will promote well-being and stability. Food pantry items especially needed include protein in a can (tuna, Spam, Ravioli, Beef-a-Roni), ketchup, BBQ sauce, pickles, canned tomatoes (all varieties), dish soap, Windex, all-purpose cleaner, body wash, shampoo, conditioner, and sunscreen. We currently do not have room for pasta, corn, or any types of beans.

<u>Rochester Deaf Kitchen</u> is a local food pantry program serving Rochester's deaf community from its location on the Rochester School for the Deaf campus. A variety of food items are needed.


<u>The Oak Tree Pantry</u> serves those with food insecurity in the Nazareth University community. Specific needs for the Oak Tree Food Pantry include items that can be easily prepared by students, including soups, canned meats and vegetables, and sauces. The pantry also needs granola bars, pasta, peanut butter, soap, and other hygiene products.
