#### SCHOOL TAX 2024-2025 INFORMATION

Collection of school taxes shall commence on September 1, 2024, as follows:

#### School Tax Collection locations and hours:

• Town of Pittsford, Town Clerk/Tax Receivers Office: 11 South Main St; Monday – Friday 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM



- Town of Pittsford Drop Box locations: 11 South Main St; at front & back doors open 24 hours
- Canandaigua National Bank and Trust: 18 State St; Monday Friday 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM and Saturdays 9:00 AM to 1:00 PM (September 1 – October 1 only)

#### **Full Payments**

Interest Free: **Sept 1 - Oct 1** 2% interest added: Oct 2 - Nov 1

#### **Installment Payments**

1st payment due by Sept 15 Sept 16 - Sept 20 ADD 1% **No Installments after Sept 20** 2nd & 3rd payments send to Monroe County Treasurer

All payments must include a phone number and payment coupon (the 2 <sup>nd</sup> page of your bill)

- Full and 1<sup>st</sup> installment payments: make payable to RENEE MCQUILLEN, RECEIVER OF TAXES
- Per NYS Real Property Law, the **US postmark is used to determine the payment date** for tax payments received by mail. Payments postmarked after the due date will be assessed interest.
- If a due date falls on a weekend or holiday , payment is accepted without penalty the next business day.
- Online bank account payment is not recommended. These payments arrive without a postmark and cannot count as received until arrival in the tax office. This will result in additional interest if not received by the due date.
- You **may pay online by credit card** at <u>www.monroecounty.gov/etc/rp/</u>. An additional service fee totaling 2.75% of amount to be paid will be added by the credit card processor. Any payment less than \$100 will be charged \$2.75.
- Electronic check payments can be made at <a href="www.monroecounty.gov/etc/rp/">www.monroecounty.gov/etc/rp/</a> and are assessed a sliding scale fee based on the payment amount.

Please contact the Pittsford Tax Office at <u>Townclerk@townofpittsford.org</u> or 248-6215 if you DO NOT receive your tax bill by September 9, 2024. You can also use the Monroe County Real Property portal on <u>www.monroecounty.gov/etc/rp/</u> to obtain a copy of your bill.

#### FOOD TRUCK AND MUSIC FEST IS SEPT. 14!



We'll have a variety of great food from mobile cuisine vendors and local eateries, a wine and beer garden, family activities, amusement rides, and children's entertainment – and Village merchants will be open for business too. Enjoy the best in live music all day – **Hey Mabel** kicks off the event at noon with pop and blues rock. At 2:00pm **Begging Angels** brings country, southern rock and classic rock to our stage, and at 5:00pm we've got acoustic Americana, with **BarnSalt**. Then <u>Atlas</u> brings the high-energy party music to the stage at 7:00pm. Plus we'll have fireworks over the canal to close out the night!

#### PYS DUCK DROP TICKETS ON SALE – DUCK DROP IS SEPT. 14 AT FOOD TRUCK & MUSIC FEST

<u>Pittsford Youth Services' Duck Drop Derby</u> tickets currently are on sale! The annual rubber duck race on the canal will be held on Saturday, September 14 at 4:00pm in Carpenter Park at the Port of Pittsford, during the <u>Town's Main Street Food Truck & Music</u> <u>Fest</u>. Funds raised from this event go directly toward providing vital professional, confidential and affordable social work and counseling services to

youth and their families in our community. A ticket gets you a duck in the race and helps support an organization that does so much for the families in our community!

The Duck Drop is Pittsford Youth Services' largest fundraiser. Contributions go directly toward services for youth and families in need right here in our community. PYS has been providing affordable, accessible and confidential counseling and support services since 1969 – that's 55 years! It's the perfect opportunity to be part of a fun community tradition while supporting the good work PYS does for our youth.

Admission to the Duck Drop is free and open to the public but if you want a duck to race, you have to buy a ticket! Buy your tickets now and take advantage of the special "family of four" for \$30, or you can buy a "flock" of 8 for \$50. Individual tickets are \$10 each. In addition to prizes for the winning ducks, there will be raffle and silent auction opportunities for some special prizes!

**Tickets for the Duck Drop are being sold at various locations around Town**, including the Pittsford Dairy, along Schoen Place and at other locations around the Village. Street (enter on side of building). Tickets can be purchased by calling the PYS office at 264-0604 or stopping by the office (4 South Main Street). PYS office hours are typically 9:00am-3:00pm, but please call ahead to make sure someone is there to handle ticket sales. # FUN AND HEALTHY EXERCISE FOR SENIORS OFFERED AT THE COMMUNITY CENTER

Exercise is especially important for older adults; it offsets physical effects of aging by staving off disease, managing chronic pain, improving cognitive function, and lowering the risk of falls. Exercise is one of the best ways seniors can maintain their independence and live full, active lives!



Fall is the ideal time to start an exercise routine. The cooler temperatures and crisp air make

outdoor activities like walking, hiking or gardening more enjoyable. With fewer daylight hours, regular exercise can help regulate sleep patterns and improve mood. Fall is also a great time to take advantage of indoor fitness classes offered at the Spiegel Pittsford Community Center.

We offer eleven diverse and fun exercise programs throughout the week that are especially designed for senior citizens and are **free of charge for all Pittsford residents** and just \$3.00 for non-residents. Classes listed as "free" are open to all who attend. **Pre-registration is required for in-person exercise classes**. Please call the Senior Programs Office at 248-6235 to register and for more information.

IMPORTANT: Before you begin ANY new exercise program, talk with your doctor who can advise you on what type of program would be best based on your physical ability.

- Balance Class: Tuesdays from 10:30 11:15am.
- Line Dancing: Wednesdays from 9:30 10:30am. Advanced class meets Wednesdays from 10:30-11:30am.
- Get Fit and Stress Less: Wednesdays from 1:15 2:15pm.
- Square Dancing: Fridays from 2:00 3:45pm.
- Arthritis Senior Fitness: Mondays and Wednesdays from 10:00 11:00am.
- Seniors Yoga: Mondays and Fridays from 9:00am 9:50am.
- Nia: Mind-Body-Spirit-Fitness: Mondays from 9:30 10:30am.
- Balance Class: online program, free for all participants, meets every first, second, and third Monday of the month, 12:15 1:30pm.
- Tai Chi for Arthritis and Fall Prevention : Tuesdays and Thursdays from 1:00 2:00pm.
- Feldenkrais Method Exercise Class: first two Wednesdays of each month at 11:15am, free for all participants.

All in-person classes take place at the Spiegel Pittsford Community Center, located at 35 Lincoln Avenue. Our Balance Class, is offered online. You can find out more about each class by looking in the Fall Pittsford Recreation brochure recently mailed to


# ZONING CODE REVISION MEETING NOW AVAILABLE FOR ONLINE VIEWING

# ASL INTERPRETER ALWAYS AVAILABLE AT TOWN BOARD MEETINGS

The Town of Pittsford has an American Sign Language interpreter available at every Pittsford Town Board meeting, to interpret for those who need this service. Those who can't attend a Town Board meeting in person but are planning to watch the meeting's live stream can confirm their need for the interpreter by emailing <u>comments@townofpittsford.org</u>. Requests can be made in advance or can be emailed through the first ten minutes of the meeting.
