### A Message from Town Supervisor Bill Smith: REMEMBERING 9/11

In the earlier days of my legal career I worked for eight years in Two World Trade Center. Today we mark the grim anniversary of the terrorist attack that destroyed it and its twin tower, cruelly murdering nearly 3,000 innocent human souls. The evil behind this mass murder plagues humanity yet today, with the same cruel disregard for human life as we saw last October in Israel.

We mourn those lost. We remember the heroism of the first responders, New York City's police, firefighters and emergency medical personnel. At grave personal risk they demonstrated the best of the



human spirit and the American ethic in their rescue efforts. Some responders died at the site; others years later from after-effects. The photo above shows NYFD Ladder 118, on the bridge, en route to the site of the disaster. All six of its firefighters made their last run that morning. After helping hundreds escape the doomed Marriott World Trade Center Hotel, they went back to help more. Then the towers collapsed.

The twin towers stood for 30 years as icons of the New York skyline. The courage shown by the men of Ladder 118, by the other first responders and by the people of our country in coming together in defiance of terrorism stand forever as icons of the American ideal. An ideal embraced by all, of every background, every ethnicity, every religion, who believe in democracy and peace.

## SCHOOL TAXES: FIRST INSTALLMENT DUE BY THIS SUNDAY, 9/15

Please note these dates for on-time first installments and full payments for school taxes:

- On-time first installment school tax payments
  are due by this Sunday, September 15. Due to
  September 15 falling on a weekend, all
  payments received or postmarked Monday, September 16 will be processed as
  on time.
- On-time full payments are due by Tuesday, October 1.

Payments may be made in person, by mail or by secure drop box available 24/7; drop boxes are located at both the front and back entrances of the Pittsford Town Hall, 11 South Main Street. If you will be sending your payment by mail or drop box, please include your payment coupon and a contact phone number on your check. Failure to do so increases processing time. Payments also can be made at Canandaigua National Bank, 18 State Street, in Pittsford Village or online through Monroe County; there will be a 2.75% fee to use this online payment service. To pay online, click HERE.

Please Note: We strongly discourage paying your tax bill via your banking Electronic Checking/Online bill pay system. If you are paying your bill with an online bill pay system, please be aware that your bank still mails us a paper check without a USPS postmark. Therefore, your payment is not considered received until we physically receive the payment in our office. We do not recommend sending payment in this manner.



friends from the Pittsford Community Library. We even have monthly special guest visits!



#### NARCAN TRAINING & SERVICES INFO AT LIBRARY TOMORROW, 9/12 - LEARN TO SAFELY STOP AN OPIOID OVERDOSE

The Pittsford Community Library will offer free public Narcan training and opioid awareness information tomorrow – Thursday, September 12 – from 10:00am - 1:00pm in the Library hallway. Stop by to receive a free Narcan training and a Narcan kit from the Monroe County Health Department. Narcan (Naloxone) is a nasal spray that can be administered immediately to treat an opioid overdose. The opioid

crisis continues at an alarming level. **Approximately every other day, someone in Monroe County dies from an opioid overdose.** There is no community immune to this

crisis – learn how to save a life with Narcan. This drop-in program is free; no registration required.


### HAND HARVESTING NATIVE WILDFLOWER SEED WORKSHOP – 9/22

Color Pittsford Green is offering an exciting program for native plant growers on Sunday, September 22. Pittsford resident Sarah Sutton will be leading a hands-on workshop centering on small scale seed harvesting and threshing. Learn about different methods of stratification and direct sowing in the fall to increase habitat and diversity. The workshop will take place at the Great Embankment Park Pavilion, 631 Marsh Road, from 2:00 - 4:00pm on September 22. The workshop is free and open to the public.



Sarah Sutton specializes in plant propagation of native perennials, trees, and shrubs at White Oak Nursery. Last year, Sarah completed the Ontario County Master Gardener Program and started her own NYS-licensed nursery, Spicebush Swallowtail Native Plants in Pittsford, with a focus on using local ecotype resilient seed to grow plants.


Admission to the Duck Drop is free and open to the public but if you want a duck to race, you have to buy a ticket! Buy your tickets now and take advantage of the special "family of four" for \$30, or you can buy a "flock" of 8 for \$50. Individual tickets are \$10 each. In addition to prizes for the winning ducks, there will be raffle and silent auction opportunities for some special prizes!
