SCHOOL TAXES: FULL PAYMENTS DUE THIS TUESDAY, 10/1


School Tax **on-time full payments** are due by **this Tuesday, October 1**. For your convenience, the Tax Receiver's Office will be open from 8:00am to 5:00pm on Tuesday, October 1.



Payments may be made in person, by mail or by

secure drop box available 24/7; drop boxes are located at both the front and back entrances of the Pittsford Town Hall, 11 South Main Street. Please include your payment coupon and a contact phone number on your check. Failure to do so increases processing time. Payments also can be made at Canandaigua National Bank, 18 State Street, in Pittsford Village or online through Monroe County; there will be a 2.75% fee to use this online payment service. To pay online, click <u>HERE</u>.

Canandaigua National Bank will continue to accept *full payments only* through October 1.



Second and third installment payments cannot be accepted at Town Hall. Second and third installments should be made payable to: Monroe County Treasurer and may be mailed to PO Box 14420, Rochester NY 14614 or delivered in person to the Monroe County Office of the Treasury, 39 West Main Street, Monroe County Office Building Room B-2, Rochester NY 14614.

Full payments with 2% interest will be accepted from October 3 - October 31 at Pittsford Town Hall. If you need assistance in that calculation, please contact the tax office directly by email at <u>townclerk@townofpittsford.org</u> or phone 585-248-6215 for the correct amount due.

Please Note: We strongly discourage paying your tax bill via your banking Electronic Checking/Online bill pay system. If you are paying your bill with an online bill pay system, please be aware that your bank still mails us a paper check without a USPS postmark. Therefore, your payment is not considered received until we physically receive the payment in our office. We do not recommend sending payment in this manner.

SEPTEMBER IS OVARIAN CANCER AWARENESS MONTH – KNOW THE SYMPTOMS AND RISK FACTORS

In recognition of September as Ovarian Cancer Awareness Month, <u>Turn the Towns Teal</u> encourages all to learn the often silent symptoms of ovarian cancer and

help spread the word - you could help save a life!

Potential Symptoms of Ovarian Cancer:

- Pelvic or abdominal pain
- Vague but persistent gastrointestinal upsets such as gas, nausea, or indigestion
- Difficulty eating OR feeling full quickly
- Urinary symptoms (urgency or frequency)
- Unexplained changes in bowel habits
- Unexplained weight gain/loss
- Ongoing unusual fatigue
- Back Pain
- Menstrual changes
- Pain during intimacy

If these symptoms persist for 10 days to two weeks, consult your gynecologist, physician, or a gynecological oncologist.

Risk Factors Linked to Ovarian Cancer:

- Genetic predisposition (BRCA1/BRCA2 gene)
- Personal or family history of breast, ovarian or colon cancer
- Increasing age
- Reproductive history and infertility
- Hormone replacement therapy


