

- Nonresidential Districts Regulations





Message from Town Supervisor Bill Smith: REPORT CARD FROM THE STATE COMPTROLLER

The State Comptroller's office has sent me its annual evaluation of the Town of Pittsford's fiscal stress. The Comptroller rates each town on a scale of 1 to

10. The more stress, the higher the number. So it's like a golf score. The lower the number, the better you've done.

On the scale of 1 to 10, Pittsford's number? Zero.

On a fiscal stress scale of 1 to 10, we're not on the scale at all. No fiscal stress whatsoever.

You may rely upon me to continue the approach to Town budgeting – and to Town policy – that gets us report cards like these.


FAMILY HALLOWEEN FEST IS SUNDAY, 10/20 At the Spiegel Pittsford Community Center, parking at Sutherland High School

PITTSFORD ROTARY FOOD DRIVE THIS SATURDAY, 9AM – 12PM

The Rotary Club of Pittsford's next food drive is scheduled for this Saturday, October 5, from 9:00am-noon at the Pittsford Sutherland High School bus loop. In addition to the **Pittsford Food Cupboard**, donations will support Rochester's **St. Joseph's Neighborhood Center** and the Nazareth University **Oak Tree Food Pantry**. *Gently used recent issues (past 12*)

months) of magazines will also be collected for distribution to various social agencies in the Rochester area.

The <u>Pittsford Food Cupboard</u> plays a crucial role in addressing food insecurity within our community. Donations help ensure that local families have access to essential food items that will promote well-being and stability. The pantry is currently in need of protein in a can (tuna, chicken, Vienna sausage, sardines, beef chili, hash, Spam, hearty soup with 6 grams of protein or more). They're also in need of dog and cat food. They currently have no room for corn or any type of canned beans and they do not accept perishables.

<u>St. Joseph's Neighborhood Center</u> is a small food pantry serving residents in the Cathedral neighborhood of Rochester. It is a client choice food pantry, meaning each guest can make individual food choices according to distribution guidelines. In additional to food items, the center is also in need of hygiene and cleaning products, such as soap, shampoo, toothbrushes and toothpaste, and deodorant, hand sanitizer and disinfectant wipes. New gloves, mittens, hats, socks and scarves are also welcome in anticipation of the cold months ahead.

<u>The Oak Tree Pantry</u> serves those with food insecurity in the Nazareth University community. Specific needs for the Oak Tree Food Pantry include items that can be easily prepared by students, including soups, canned meats and vegetables, and sauces. The pantry has an ongoing need for granola bars, pasta, peanut butter, soap and other hygiene products.


