KEEP DEBRIS OUT OF LEAF PILES FOR TOWN LEAF PICKUP

The leaves are finally changing and beginning to fall! Approximately every three weeks Town of Pittsford Crews will be picking up loose leaf piles in your neighborhood beginning this Monday, October 21. Remember that when it comes to Town leaf pickup, it is imperative to keep debris out of your leaf piles. Debris like rocks, sticks, or broken glass can cause a serious safety hazard to both our pickup crews and the public.

Tips for keeping debris out of leaf piles:

• **Rake carefully:** Be mindful of any debris that may be hidden in the leaves.



- **Remove large items:** Separate large items like branches or twigs for disposal or recycling.
- Check for hidden objects: Look for any objects that may have been accidentally buried in the leaves, such as toys or tools.

By following these guidelines, you can help ensure a smooth and efficient leaf pickup process while also contributing to a cleaner and healthier community. 


Death & Despair: Mourning in Pittsford - 10/23

York public school children. School Board Recognition Week provides an opportunity to raise community awareness and understanding about the crucial role school board members play in shaping the educational landscape of their communities.




