2025 TOWN AND COUNTY TAX BILLS HAVE BEEN MAILED – DUE 2/10

If you are not in escrow, you should have received your 2025 Town and County property tax bill in the mail by this time. If you have not, please do one of the following:

1) Download and print a copy directly from the <u>Monroe County website</u>

2) Call the Town Tax Office at 585-248-6215; or email the Town Clerk/Tax Receiver at:



townclerk@townofpittsford.org and they will email a copy of the bill to you.

The interest-free Town and County property tax payment deadline is 2/10; first installments are also accepted on or before 2/10. Please be sure to read all the instructions and information written on the back of your bill carefully. *Please include your payment coupon (page 2 of your bill) and a contact phone number on your check.* Failure to do so increases processing time.

You can make your payment by:

- By mail to: Renee McQuillen, Receiver, 11 South Main Street, Pittsford NY 14534
- In person, Monday through Friday 8 AM to 4 PM at Pittsford Town Hall, 11 South Main Street, or through the mail slots (into locked boxes) available 24/7, located at both the front and back entrances.
 - For cash payments, we ask that you bring the exact amount and please call ahead for an appointment to ensure we have proper staffing.
- First Installments and full payments can also be made at Canandaigua National Bank, 18 State Street, in Pittsford Village through February 10, 2025.
- Online through Monroe County by credit card or check debit. Please note there is a 2.75% fee to pay by credit card and a sliding scale fee to pay by check debit. To pay online, click <u>HERE</u>.

As in the past we **strongly** advise that you do NOT pay by electronic check, as these payments do not receive a U.S. postmark and may arrive late. If you choose to pay your tax bill with an online bill pay (electronic banking) system through your bank,

please be aware that your bank still generates and mails a paper check to the Town, and it may take as long as two weeks or more to reach the Town offices. This type of mail does not receive a USPS postmark. Therefore, the Town can only consider your payment received on the date it is physically received in our office. If the payment is received past the deadline, it will be considered late and accrue interest penalties.

NYS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TRAFFIC COUNTING CAMERAS COMING TO PITTSFORD


The State Department of Transportation (DOT) is placing traffic counting cameras around the county, including nine located here in Pittsford. The cameras will be installed on state Routes to measure traffic at the following locations:

- Marsh Road near the I-490 overpass
- State Street/Palmyra Road between Main Street and Marsh Road
- East Jefferson Road between South Main Street and South Street
- South Main Street between Jefferson Road and Monroe Avenue/State Street.
- Clover Street between Stone Road and Tobey Road
- East Jefferson Road between East Street and Mitchell Road
- West Jefferson Road between Greenpoint Trail South Main Street
- Calkins Road between Mendon Center Road and Mendon Road

The DOT confirms that the cameras are for traffic-counting purposes only. For questions or additional information, you may contact the local office of the DOT at (585) 272-3310.




Last year, the AARP served a total of 563 clients! Each
