NOW IS THE TIME TO SIGN UP FOR A REFUSE DISTRICT

A refuse district is a designated area where a single refuse collector serves all households in the district. Refuse districts have many advantages and are gaining popularity in Pittsford! The Town now has 3,323 homes – 36% of all the homes within Pittsford – enrolled in refuse districts. District

residents enjoy lower costs, fewer bills, and decreased neighborhood traffic, making them quieter, safer, and better for the environment. Additionally, trash and recycling are only out on those neighborhoods' streets one day each week.

Residents have until April 30 to establish a refuse district that will commence service on January 1, 2026. So, to those who love to plan, now's the time to talk with your neighbors, get your petition forms from the Town, and obtain signatures from those who



want to be included. It's up to residents to form their districts, which can vary in size. The smallest current district has seven homes, while the largest has 264! Talk to your neighbors to see if they'd like to participate in adopting a refuse district.

NARCAN TRAINING & SERVICES INFO AT LIBRARY THIS TUESDAY, 2/25 - LEARN TO STOP AN OPIOID OVERDOSE SAFELY

The Pittsford Community Library will offer free public Narcan training and opioid awareness information this Tuesday, February 25, from 1:00 - 4:00pm in the Library hallway. Stop by for free Narcan training and a Narcan kit from the Monroe County Health Department.

Narcan (Naloxone) is a nasal spray that can be administered immediately to treat an opioid overdose. The opioid crisis continues at an alarming level. Approximately every other day, someone in Monroe County dies from an opioid overdose. No community is immune to this crisis – learn how to save a life with Narcan. This drop-in program is free; no registration is required.



Pittsford Town Board meetings are being streamed live; the feed is accessible on any device. Town Board is typically held the first and third Tuesday of the month at 6:00pm at Town Hall. This link can also be found on page two of the meeting agenda. The meeting agenda is posted on the Town's

minutes and agendas page at least two days prior to the meeting. Please note: if you try to log in too early (before the meeting feed is live) you will see an error message; refresh your screen just prior to or at 6:00pm when the board meeting starts and you will be able to view the meeting. As always, ASL interpretation is provided for every Town Board meeting.

The Town of Pittsford has an American Sign Language interpreter available at every Pittsford Town Board meeting, to interpret for those who need this service.
