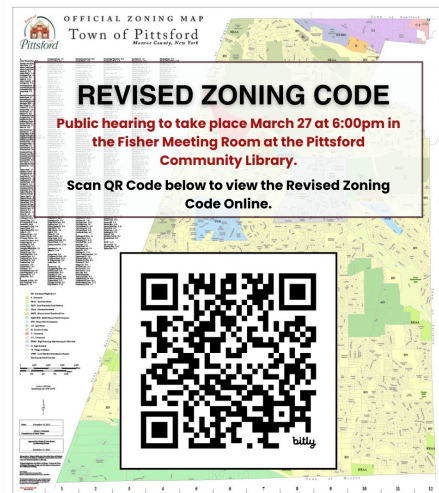

PUBLIC HEARING FOR THE PROPOSED REVISED ZONING 3/27

**The public hearing will be held in the Fisher
Meeting Room at the Pittsford Community
Library*

The Town is in the final phase of adopting a revised Zoning Code. The public hearing on the proposed revised Zoning Code continues next [Thursday, March 27](#), at which we anticipate a final vote of the Town Board to adopt a new code. The meeting begins at 6:00pm in the Fisher Room at the Pittsford Community Library, 24 State Street. By law, the Zoning Code must be in accordance with the Town's Comprehensive Plan.



Please attend the hearing if possible. The hearing is open to the public and will be live-streamed. You can offer comments during the hearing. Those unable to attend the hearing can submit comments before or during the hearing to zoningupdate@townofpittsford.org.

SEASONAL HIGHWAY & PARKS DEPARTMENT JOB OPENINGS

**Application Deadline is April 3 for the Highway Department Seasonal Laborer position and April 30 for all other positions.*

The Town of Pittsford has several seasonal job openings in the Parks and Highway Departments. The Highway Department has an opening for a **Seasonal Laborer (part-time)** position. **Highway Laborers** perform a wide range of services for the Highway Department, including road and drainage work, brush clean up, asphalt work, directing traffic, leaf pickup, etc.

The Parks Department has openings for **Gardeners, Seasonal Laborers, and Parks Patrol** positions. **Park Department Laborers' duties** include mowing, trimming, weeding, playing field preparation, trail work, and a variety of other tasks. **Gardeners** maintain grounds by planting, weeding, edging, watering, trimming, mulching, and through site cleanup. **Parks Patrol** employees perform many of the same duties as Parks Department Laborers and are also responsible for lodge reservations, including check-in and check-out, cleaning, minor repairs, and problem-solving.

The application deadline for the Highway Laborer position is April 3, 2025. The application deadline for all other positions listed above is April 30, 2024. NOW IS THE TIME TO SIGN UP FOR A REFUSE DISTRICT

A refuse district is a designated area where a single refuse collector serves all households in the district. Refuse districts have many advantages and are gaining popularity in Pittsford! The Town now has 3,323 homes – 36% of all the homes within Pittsford – enrolled in refuse districts. District residents enjoy lower costs, fewer bills, and decreased neighborhood traffic, making them quieter, safer, and better for the environment. Additionally, trash and recycling are only out on those neighborhoods' streets one day each week.

REFUSE DISTRICTS ARE CATCHING ON!



**Enrollment for service beginning in 2026 ends
April 30, 2025**

District residents enjoy lower costs, fewer bills, and decreased traffic in their neighborhoods—making them quieter, safer, and better for the environment.

Residents have until **April 30** to establish a refuse district that will commence service on **January 1, 2026**. So, to those who love to plan, now's the time to talk with your neighbors, get your petition forms from the Town, and obtain signatures from those who want to be included.

It's up to residents to form their districts, which can vary in size. The smallest current district has seven homes, while the largest has 264! Talk to your neighbors to see if they'd like to participate in adopting a refuse district.

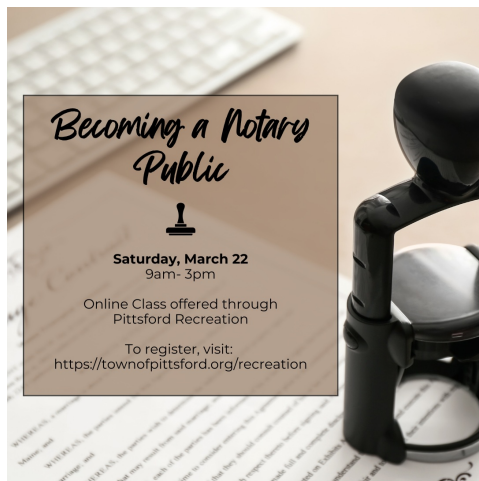



PITTSFORD BLOOD DRIVE HELPED 87 PEOPLE

The Pittsford Community Library hosts a monthly blood drive for the Red Cross. The last drive, held on March 7, collected 29 units of blood, enough to help 87 people! Christine Broadway, a surgical technologist who is also a Red Cross blood donor, says the following:

“When I saw firsthand the high amount of products we used for just one patient, I knew I wanted to try donating. I chose platelets because it always seemed like there was a shortage of those in the hospital. I wanted to be a part of helping shortages of those products because I was

experiencing right in front of me how it literally saves lives!”

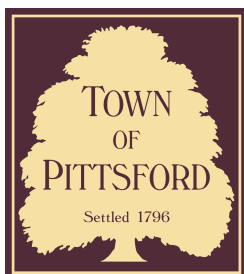
According to the Red Cross, Christine was told that her most recent donation of platelets was delivered to the hospital where she works.

In honor of American Red Cross Month, here are some facts about blood donation:

- One blood donation can save up to three lives.
- Every two seconds, someone in the United States needs blood.
- Platelets, crucial for clotting, have a very short shelf life of only about five days.
- AB plasma is the universal plasma.
- You can donate whole blood every 56 days; platelets can be donated every 7 days, up to 24 times per year.
- There is no substitute for human blood.

The Library’s next blood drive is scheduled for **Friday, April 4, from 10:00am to 3:00pm**. However, you can donate blood any time at ANY drive location. Simply visit <https://www.redcrossblood.org/give.html/find-drive> to find a place and time that’s convenient for you.
