PEDDLER AND SOLICITOR PERMITS

If you do not want solicitation to occur at your door, you can post a “No Solicitation” sign on your property (on the door, a window or in your yard), and the solicitor must adhere to the sign, or their permit can be revoked.

NOTE: If a solicitor comes to your door and they are **NOT** listed below, please call the Town Code Enforcement (585-248-6260) to report immediately, with the name of the company and the street name of where they are soliciting. If it is not during business hours, you may call the Monroe County Sheriff’s 911 number and say it is a “non-emergency call” to report. Please leave a message with the Town also.
